Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Motor Vehicles Variation Regulations 2012*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which section 4 of the *Road Traffic (Red Light Offences) Amendment Act 2011* comes into operation.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Motor Vehicles Regulations 2010*

4—Variation of Schedule 4—Demerit points

Schedule 4, clause 1, item relating to section 79B(2) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961*, sub-item relating to rule 123(a) of the *Australian Road Rules*—delete the sub-item and substitute:

r 123(a)—*Entering level crossing in certain circumstances*
Entering level crossing while twin red lights are operating 3

Note—
