Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Firearms Variation Regulations 2013*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Firearms Regulations 2008*

4—Variation of Regulation 5A—Fit and proper person

- (1) Regulation 5A(a)—before paragraph (a) insert:
 - (aa) *Bail Act 1985*—section 11A(2) (Bail authority may direct person to surrender firearm etc);
 - (2) Regulation 5A(a)—after paragraph (a) insert:
 - (ab) *Correctional Services Act 1982*—section 68A(2) (Board may direct person to surrender firearm etc);
 - (ac) *Criminal Law (Sentencing) Act 1988*—section 24A(2) (Appropriate board may direct person to surrender firearm etc);
 - (3) Regulation 5A(b)—after "section 19AA (Unlawful stalking);" insert:
 - section 29A (Shooting at police officers);

- (4) Regulation 5A(b) after "section 32 (Possession of a firearm with intent to commit an offence);" insert:
- section 32AA (Discharge of firearms to injure etc);
- (5) Regulation 5A(d)—after paragraph (d) insert:
- (da) *Young Offenders Act 1993*—section 41D(2) (Training Centre Review Board may direct youth to surrender firearm etc);
