Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Parliament (Joint Services) (Retention Entitlement) Variation Regulations 2013*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Parliament (Joint Services) (Retention Entitlement) Regulations 2012*

4—Variation of regulation 4—Retention leave

Regulation 4—after subregulation (2) insert:

- (2a) An amount determined under subregulation (2) is to be rounded up or down to the nearest \$1 (and if the amount to be rounded is 50 cents, then the amount is to be rounded up).
