Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Criminal Law (Sentencing) Variation Regulations 2014*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Insertion of regulation 13A

After regulation 13 insert:

13A—Prescribed unit

For the purposes of section 70U of the Act, the prescribed unit is \$100.
