## **Part 1—Preliminary**

### **1—Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Fisheries Management (General) Variation Regulations 2016*.

### **2—Commencement**

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

### **3—Variation provisions**

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

## **Part 2—Variation of *Fisheries Management (General) Regulations 2007***

### **4—Variation of regulation 23—Berleying**

Regulation 23—after subregulation (1) insert:

- (1a) Subregulation (1)(b) does not apply to the use of blood, bone, meat, offal or skin of an animal as berley in the Neptune Islands Group (Ron and Valerie Taylor) Marine Park established under section 10 of the *Marine Parks Act 2007* if that use is authorised under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*.
