Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) (Simplify) Variation Regulations 2016*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation 4 months after the day on which they are made (see *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978* section 10AA).

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2014*

4—Variation of regulation 50—Child restraints, safety harnesses, booster seats etc

Regulation 50(1)—delete subregulation (1) and substitute:

- (1) A device that complies with Australian/New Zealand Standard (AS/NZS) 1754—*Child restraint systems for use in motor vehicles* and is clearly marked with a prescribed certification mark certifying compliance with the standard is an approved child restraint.
