Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Passenger Transport* (Non-cash Payment Surcharges) Variation Regulations 2017.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which Part 8 of the *Statutes Amendment (Budget 2016) Act 2016* comes into operation.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of Passenger Transport Regulations 2009

4—Insertion of regulation 64B

After regulation 64A insert:

64B—Non-cash payment surcharges for hiring taxis

For the purposes of Part 6A of the Act, the maximum amount payable for a non-cash payment surcharge for the hiring of a taxi is 5% of the total amount payable for the hiring. Note—
