### **Part 1—Preliminary**

#### **1—Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Young Offenders Variation Regulations 2018*.

#### **2—Commencement**

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which section 28 of the *Statutes Amendment (Terror Suspect Detention) Act 2017* comes into operation.

#### **3—Variation provisions**

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

### **Part 2—Variation of *Young Offenders Regulations 2008***

#### **4—Insertion of regulation 7A**

Before regulation 8 insert:

##### **7A—Definition of terrorist offence**

For the purposes of paragraph (e) of the definition of *terrorist offence* in section 4(1) of the Act, the following kinds of offences are prescribed:

- (a) an offence against section 83CA of the *Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935*;
- (b) any offence against Part 3D of the *Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935*;

- (c) an offence against section 37 of the *Summary Offences Act 1953*.

**Note—**

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
