Controlled Substances (Controlled Drugs, Precursors and Plants) (N-Ethylpentylone) Variation Regulations 2019

under the Controlled Substances Act 1984

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Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Controlled Substances* (*Controlled Drugs, Precursors and Plants*) (*N-Ethylpentylone*) Variation Regulations 2019.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Variation of Schedule 1—Controlled drugs
