For each application to inspect a record or any other documentary or evidentiary material

\$25.30

- For a copy of the transcript of evidence, or the findings and any recommendations of the Court, or an order made by the Court—
  - (a) in electronic form

\$8.50 per page

(b) in hard-copy form

\$10.90 per page

#### Note—

1 copy will be supplied to a person who appears before the Court under section 20 of the Act free of charge in electronic form or hard-copy form, as specified by the person.

3 For a copy of any other document

\$5.10 per page
