Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Criminal Law* (*Clamping, Impounding and Forfeiture of Vehicles*) Variation Regulations 2019.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 1 May 2019.

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Variation of regulation 4—Prescribed offences

(1) Regulation 4(b)—delete "or 47BA" and substitute:

(2) Regulation 4(g)—after "74(2a)" insert:

, 74(2ab), 74(2ac)
