Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the Food (Fees) Variation Regulations 2019.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 1 July 2019.

Schedule 1—Fees

The following fees are payable under the Act and these regulations:

- Application for approval of food safety auditors (section 73(3)(b) of Act)
 - (a) in the case of a Public Service employee employed for the purpose of carrying out the functions of a food safety auditor
 - (b) in any other case

2 Inspection fee (regulation 13)—the reasonable costs incurred in carrying out the inspection, but not exceeding—

(a) in the case of a small business
