Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure (Swimming Pool Safety) Variation Regulations 2019*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Planning, Development and Infrastructure (Swimming Pool Safety) Regulations 2019*

4—Variation of regulation 6—Requirements for designated safety features for swimming pools

- (1) Regulation 6(1)—delete "and (3)(a)"
 - (2) Regulation 6—after subregulation (1) insert:
 - (1a) For the purposes of section 156(3)(a) of the Act—
 - (a) the requirements under subregulation (1) are prescribed; and

- (b) the designated owner of a swimming pool must ensure that designated safety features are installed and maintained in accordance with the relevant requirements under subregulation (1).
