Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Child Sex Offenders Registration (Savings and Transitional) Variation Regulations 2021*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which the *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (CIPIC Recommendations) Amendment Act 2021* comes into operation.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Insertion of Schedule 1

After regulation 18 insert:

Schedule 1—Savings and transitional provisions (Schedule 1 clause 76 of *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (CPIPC Recommendations) Amendment Act 2021*)

1—Application of Act to continuing complaints etc

The Act as in force before the commencement of Schedule 1 of the *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (CPIPC Recommendations) Amendment Act 2021* continues to apply in connection with any complaint, report or investigation referred to in clause 70 of that Schedule.

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
