Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Development (Designated Day) (COVID-19) Variation Regulations 2021*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Variation of regulation 5—Application of Act

Regulation 5(5), definition of *designated day*, (b)—delete paragraph (b) and substitute:

- (b) the day on which Schedule 6 Part 2 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* comes into operation;

Note—

Schedule 6 Part 2 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* repeals the *Development Act 1993*.

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
