# **Ombudsman (Savings and Transitional) Variation Regulations 2021**

under the Ombudsman Act 1972

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## Part 1—Preliminary

### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Ombudsman (Savings and Transitional)* Variation Regulations 2021.

### 2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which the *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (CPIPC Recommendations) Amendment Act 2021* comes into operation.

### **3**—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

### 4—Insertion of Schedule 1

After regulation 3 insert:

## Schedule 1—Savings and transitional provisions (Schedule 1 clause 76 of *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (CPIPC Recommendations) Amendment Act 2021*)

### 1-Application of laws to continuing complaints etc

- (1) The Ombudsman Act 1972 as in force before the commencement of Schedule 1 of the Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (CPIPC Recommendations) Amendment Act 2021 continues to apply in connection with—
  - (a) any complaint, report or investigation referred to in clause 70 of that Schedule; and
  - (b) a complaint made on or before 25 August 2021 under any of the integrity Acts.
- (2) In this section—

integrity Acts means each of the following:

- (a) Judicial Conduct Commissioner Act 2015;
- (b) Ombudsman Act 1972;
- (c) Police Complaints and Discipline Act 2016.

#### Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
