Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Veterinary Practice (Veterinary Treatment) Variation Regulations 2021.*

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of Veterinary Practice Regulations 2017

4—Variation of regulation 5—Meaning of veterinary treatment

Regulation 5(2)—after paragraph (j) insert:

- (k) non-invasive manual physical therapy of an animal;
- (l) the use of a therapeutic device on an animal in the course of non-invasive physical therapy of the animal (other than extracorporeal shock wave therapy);
- (m) the giving of advice, and the assessment of an animal, in relation to physical therapy referred to in paragraph (k) or (l).
