Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Mental Health (Fee Notices) Amendment Regulations 2022*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 21 March 2022.

Part 2—Amendment of *Mental Health Regulations 2010*

3—Substitution of regulation 7

Regulation 7—delete the regulation and substitute:

7—Scale of legal practitioner fees (section 84(3) of Act)

A legal practitioner (not being an employee of the Crown or a statutory authority) who represents a person under section 84 of the Act is entitled to receive fees for their services from the Minister in accordance with the scale prescribed by fee notice.

4—Repeal of Schedule 1

Schedule 1—delete the Schedule
