Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Motor Vehicles (Speed Limits on Beaches) Amendment Regulations 2023*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which the *Road Traffic (Road Rules—Ancillary and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Speed Limits on Beaches) Amendment Regulations 2023* come into operation.

3—Amendment of Schedule 4—Demerit points

Schedule 4, clause 6, table—after the item relating to regulation 8(2) insert:

8A(1)	<i>Speeding while driving on beach</i>	
	Exceeding a prescribed speed limit (beaches)—	
	by less than 10 kph	2
	by 10 kph or more but less than 20 kph	3
	by 20 kph or more but less than 30 kph	5
	by 30 kph or more	7
