Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Brands Regulations 2001*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 31 August 2001.

3—Revocation

The *Brands Act Regulations 1986* (see *Gazette 10.7.1986 p232*) are revoked.

4—Interpretation

In these regulations—

Act means the *Brands Act 1933*.

5—Sheep paint brands (section 28)

A paint brand for sheep—

- (a) must be made with the substance "Si-Ro-Mark" (registered trademark no. 121839); and
- (b) must be purple, red, blue or green in colour.

6—Prescribed fees

The following fees are payable under the Act:

Item	Fee
Registration of any brand or mark	\$20
Transfer of registration	\$15
Cancellation of registration	No fee
