1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Coast Protection (Identity Card) Regulations 2001*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 September 2001.


3—Revocation

The *Coast Protection Act (Identity Card) Regulations 1985* (see *Gazette 10.10.1985 p1090*) are revoked.

4—Prescribed form for warden's identity card—section 34A(3)

An identity card issued to a warden under section 34A of the *Coast Protection Act 1972* must be in the form set out in the Schedule.
