**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Local Government (How-to-Vote Cards) Regulations, 1987*.

**Commencement**

2. These regulations shall come into operation on 8 January, 1987.

**Forms of cards**

3. How-to-vote cards submitted by candidates under section 114 of the Act for display in voting compartments at polling booths—

(a) must be printed;

\* \* \* \* \*

(c) must have printed on one side—

- (i) the words "HOW-TO-VOTE";
  - (ii) the name of the council, the name of the office and, where the election is for a ward, the name of the ward;
  - (iii) the names of all the candidates;
  - (iv) where the method of counting applying at the election is the method set out in Section 121(3)—the number "1" surrounded by a square opposite the name of one candidate, and may have consecutive numbers commencing with the number "2", each surrounded by a square, opposite the names of all or any of the other candidates;
  - (v) where the method of counting applying at the election is the method set out in section 121(4)—consecutive numbers beginning with the number "1" each surrounded by a square, opposite the names of a number of candidates being not less than the number required to be elected, and may continue with consecutive numbers, each surrounded by a square, opposite the names of one or more of the other candidates;
  - (vi) the name and address of the person who authorised the printing of the card;
- and
- (vii) the name and address of the person who printed the card;

and

(d) may have printed on the side used under paragraph (c) a reproduction in black and white of a recent full-faced vertical photograph of the head and shoulders of the candidate submitting the card.

**Card not to contain other matter**

4. Except for the matters referred to in regulation 3, no other matter may be printed or otherwise appear on the side referred to in regulation 3(c).
