Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Local Government (Section 201—Prescribed Controlling Authorities) Regulations 1997*.

Commencement

2. These regulations will come into operation on the day on which they are made.

Interpretation

3. In these regulations—

"Act" means the *Local Government Act 1934*.

Section 201—Prescribed controlling authorities

4. Pursuant to section 201(2) of the Act, the following classes of controlling authorities are prescribed:

- (a) controlling authorities established under section 199 of the Act;
- (b) controlling authorities established under section 200 of the Act as regional local government authorities primarily constituted in order to undertake co-ordinating, advocacy and representative roles for their constituent councils at the regional level.
