Maritime Services (Access) Regulations 2001

under the *Maritime Services (Access) Act 2000*

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Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Maritime Services (Access) Regulations 2001*.

3—Interpretation

In these regulations—

the Act means the *Maritime Services (Access) Act 2000*.

4—Declaration of the Port of Ardrossan (section 5(1)(g))

The Port of Ardrossan is declared to be a port capable of being brought within the application of the Act.

5—Extension of operation of Part 3 of Act

Pursuant to section 43 of the Act, Part 3 of the Act continues in operation for a further triennial cycle (commencing 31 October 2004).
