REGULATIONS UNDER THE PARLIAMENTARY SUPERANNUATION ACT 1974

Parliamentary Superannuation Regulations 1992

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Parliamentary Superannuation Regulations 1992*.

Commencement

2. These regulations will come into operation on 1 January 1992.

Revocation

3. The regulations made under the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1974* on 1 June 1978 (see *Gazette* 1 June 1978 p. 1886) are revoked.

Interpretation

4. In these regulations—

"the Act" means the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1974*.

Prescription of offices and positions

5. The following offices and positions are declared to be prescribed offices and positions for the purposes of section 19 of the Act:

- (a) membership of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia or of the Parliament of any State of the Commonwealth except South Australia;
- (b) an office by virtue of which the holder of the office is a Judge as defined by section 4 of the *Judges Pensions Act 1971*;
- (c) judicial office established by the *Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act* or by a law of the Commonwealth of Australia.
