LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Roads (Opening and Closing) Fees Regulations 1991*.

Commencement

2. These regulations will come into operation on 11 November 1991.

Interpretation

3. In these regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—

"the Act" means the *Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991*.

Fees

4. The fees set out in the schedule are payable to the Surveyor-General for the purposes set out in that schedule.

Refund of fees

5. The Surveyor-General may refund the whole or any part of a fee paid to the Surveyor-General under these regulations where—

- (a) the matter or action for which the fee was paid is of a minor nature or is not completed;

and

- (b) the Surveyor-General is of the opinion that the refund is appropriate in the circumstances.

3.	On deposit with the Surveyor-General of an agreement for transfer or exchange (on which is denoted all stamp duty payable in respect of that agreement) for processing under the Act	\$103
4.	On deposit with the Surveyor-General of a survey plan for processing under the Act—

	(i) where the plan is an uncertified data plan	\$282
	(ii) where the plan is a survey plan certified by a licensed surveyor	\$566
	plus a further \$282, payable by the surveyor, if the plan is resubmitted following rejection by the Registrar-General (However, the Registrar-General may waive or reduce the further fee if he or she considers that appropriate in a particular case having regard to the work involved in examining the resubmitted plan.)	
	(b) administration fee (payable in addition to examination fee)	\$139
5.	On deposit with the Surveyor-General of an application under the Act (on which is denoted all stamp duty payable in respect of that application) for a document of title, or for the alteration of a document of title, where there is no agreement for transfer or exchange	\$103
6.	For notification of an order or a notice by the Surveyor-General pursuant to s. 34 or s. 37 of the Act (payable prior to notification)	\$103
7.	On deposit of a document with the Surveyor-General for processing under the Act for which a fee is not otherwise provided in this schedule	\$103
8.	For the withdrawal of a document (other than a survey plan) submitted to the Surveyor-General for processing under the Act	\$37
9.	On application for a road width declaration by the Surveyor-General	\$40
