Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Youth Court (Fees) Regulations 1996*.

Commencement

2. These regulations will come into operation on 1 July 1996.

Revocation

3. The *Youth Court (Fees) Regulations 1995* (see *Gazette* 5 October 1995 p. 906) are revoked.

Interpretation

4. In these regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—

"**the Act**" means the *Youth Court Act 1993*.

Fees

5. (1) Pursuant to section 33 of the Act, the fees set out in the schedule are payable to the Court in relation to proceedings in the Court.

(2) The Court may require a non-refundable deposit as security for the payment of fees for the production of a transcript of the hearing of a case at the request of a party where the Court does not require the transcript.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Transitional Provisions
