An Act further to amend an Ordinance No. 13 of 1851, for the declaring of Main Lines of Road in South Australia.

[Assented to, June 18, 1856.]

WHEREAS, by an Act, No. 13 of 1851, certain Roads were declared to be Main Lines of Road, and, because it is expedient that the roads set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed, should also be declared to be Main Roads: Be it therefore Enacted by His Excellency the Governor-in-Chief of South Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof —That the lines of road set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed, shall be, and they are hereby declared to be Main Roads, for the purposes of all Acts relating to, or affecting the roads of the said Province.

Preamble.

Main Lines of Road declared according to Schedule.

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO.

1. A line of road branching from the Main South Road at or near Noarlunga, and running thence south, across the Aldinga Plains to the Mount Terrible Range, and crossing that range at or near Sellick's Hill, to join the road running to Yankalilla and Cape Jervis.
2. The line of road between Gawler Town and Lyndoch Valley.
3. A line of road to Port Elliot, from Strathalbyn, and a branch to Milang.
4. A line of road from Strathalbyn to Wellington.
5. A line of road from the Shea Oak Log, by Greenock, to Light Pass.
