An Act to repeal part of "The Adelaide University Act Amendment Act," No. 143 of 1879, and for other purposes.

*[Assented to, October 25th, 1880.]*

**W**HEREAS in order to enable The University of Adelaide to obtain a grant of Royal Letters Patent, and for other reasons, it is expedient to repeal part of "The Adelaide University Act Amendment Act," and to revive part of "The Adelaide University Act," and to amend it—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

Preamble.

**1.** The third section of "The Adelaide University Act Amendment Act" is hereby repealed, and so much of "The Adelaide University Act" as was repealed by that section is hereby revived.

Repeal and revival.

**2.** Women, who shall have fulfilled all the conditions prescribed by "The Adelaide University Act," and by the Statutes and Regulations of the University of Adelaide for any degree, may be admitted to that degree at a meeting of the Council and Senate of the said University.

Admission of women to degrees.

**3.** In "The Adelaide University Act," words importing the masculine gender shall be construed to include the feminine.

Words importing masculine gender include feminine.

4. This Act may be cited as "The University of Adelaide Degrees Act."
