An Act to amend the Nurses Registration Act, 1920.

[Assented to, December 13th, 1922.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Nurses Registration Act Amendment Act, 1922." Short titles.

(2) The Nurses Registration Act, 1920, and this Act may be cited together as the "Nurses Registration Acts, 1920 and 1922." No. 1451 of 1920.

(3) The Nurses Registration Act, 1920, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act."

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with principal Act.

3. Applications for registration by persons entitled to registration by virtue only of— Extension of time for making applications for registration under s. 19 and s. 20 of principal Act.

(a) subdivision III. or IV. of subsection (1) of section 19 of the principal Act ; or

(b) subdivision III. or IV. of subsection (1) of section 20 of the principal Act,

which

which have not been made within twelve months from the commencement of the principal Act, may, notwithstanding anything contained in the principal Act, be made within three months from the passing of this Act.
