An Act to amend the Nurses Registration Act, 1920.

[Assented to, December 13th, 1922.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Nurses Registration short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1922."
- (2) The Nurses Registration Act, 1920, and this Act may be cited No. 1451 of 1920. together as the "Nurses Registration Acts, 1920 and 1922."
- (3) The Nurses Registration Act, 1920, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act."
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act Incorporation with and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Applications for registration by persons entitled to registration by virtue only of—

which have not been made within twelve months from the commencement of the principal Act, may, notwithstanding anything contained in the principal Act, be made within three months from the passing of this Act.
