An Act to appropriate certain Surplus Revenue to the Repayment of certain Advances made by the Treasurer.

[Assented to, December 10th, 1925.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "Surplus Revenue Act, 1925." Short title.
2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Surplus Revenue Act, 1906, or any other Act, the sum of Fifty-three Thousand and One Pounds Six Shillings and One Penny standing to the credit of General Revenue in the accounts of the Treasurer on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, is hereby appropriated towards the repayment of certain advances made by the Treasurer, which advances are more fully described in the Schedule hereto. Appropriation of excess revenue to the extent of Fifty-three Thousand and One Pounds Six Shillings and One Penny.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
