An Act to amend the Payment of Members Acts, 1887 to 1921.

[Assented to, September 30th, 1926.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Payment of Members Act Short title. Amendment Act, 1926."

(2) The Payment of Members Acts, 1887 to 1921, and this Act may be cited together as the "Payment of Members Acts, 1887 to 1926."

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. In any case where the term of office of any Member of the Legislative Council or the House of Assembly expires by effluxion of time or by reason of the House of Assembly being dissolved by the Governor, then the salary payable to such Member pursuant to the Acts incorporated with this Act shall continue to be payable to such Member from the time of the expiration of his term of office as aforesaid until a successor is elected in his place. Members to be paid until appointment of successor.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
