An Act to amend the Highways Acts, 1926 to 1934.

[Assented to, 19th December, 1935.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Highways Act Amendment Act, 1935". Short titles.

(2) The Highways Acts, 1926 to 1934, and this Act may be cited together as the "Highways Acts, 1926 to 1935".

(3) The Highways Act, 1926, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 1769 of 1926.

2. The principal Act is amended by inserting therein after section 26A thereof the following section :— Amendment of principal Act—

26B. (1) Subject to the consent of the Minister, the Commissioner may, from time to time, plant trees in any main road and may erect tree-guards, stakes, and other supports thereof. Power to plant trees. Cf. 2156, 1934, s. 315.

(2) The Commissioner shall not be liable for any damage to any property which results from the planting of any tree in any main road.

3. Section 31A of the principal Act (as enacted by section 8 of the Highways Act, 1930, and amended by section 5 of the Highways Act Amendment Act, 1932, and section 2 of the Highways Act Amendment Act, 1934) is further amended by striking out the words “until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and thirty-five” therein and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “until the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and thirty-six”.
