An Act to amend the Registration of Dogs Act, 1924-1966.

[Assented to 19th December, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Registration of Dogs Short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1968".
- (2) The Registration of Dogs Act, 1924-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Registration of Dogs Act, 1924-1968".
- (3) The Registration of Dogs Act, 1924-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of from subsection (1) the passage "two pounds nor more than ".9 six pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "four keeping unregistered dogs dollars nor more than twelve dollars".

- 3. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "in the form in the third schedule,"; and
  - (b) by striking out from that subsection the passage "one shilling" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "ten cents".

18. Section 36 of the principal Act is repealed.

19. Section 38 of the principal Act is amended by striking Amendment of out from subsection (1) the passage "Twenty-five pounds" and s. 38 inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Fifty dollars".

Provision for use of guide dogs.

20. The first schedule to the principal Act is amended by Amendment of inserting after the passage "Sex", in the fourth column thereof first schedule. the passage "(If bitch, state if spayed)".

21. The principal Act is amended by striking out the second Repeal and replacement of schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following schedule:—

#### SECOND SCHEDULE.

Section 10.

Scale of Fees for Registration of Dogs.	\$
For every male dog or spayed bitch	1.00
For every bitch not being a spayed bitch	1.50

If any fee for the registration of a dog is not paid before the expiration of 60 days after the last day on which, pursuant to this Act, the dog should have been registered the fee shall be increased by an amount of \$1.00.

22. The principal Act is amended by striking out the third schedule.

# Amendment of principal Act, fifth schedule.

- 23. The principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out from the fifth schedule the symbols "s. d." and inserting in lieu thereof the symbol "\$";
  - (b) by striking out from that schedule the figures "10 0" and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1.00"; and
  - (c) by striking out from that schedule the figures "3 and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "0.30".
