An Act to amend the Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1970.

[Assented to 19th November, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Motor Vehicles Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1970".

(2) The Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1970, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1970".

(3) The Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1970, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 76—
Licence and learner's permit fee.**

2. Section 76 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (a) after the passage "Class B" the passage "in respect of any period that commenced before the first day of January, 1971,";

(b) by inserting after paragraph (a) the following paragraph:—

(aa) for a licence of Class A or a licence of Class B in respect of any period commencing on or after the first day of January, 1971, shall be three dollars;;

(c) by striking out from paragraph (ii) of the proviso thereto the passage "one-half of the fee otherwise payable" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "one dollar";

and

(d) by inserting after paragraph (ii) in the proviso thereto, the following paragraph:—

(iii) the fee for a licence issued to a person who is in receipt of a pension paid or payable under any Act or law of the Commonwealth and who is, by virtue of being in receipt of such a pension, entitled to travel in any public transport in South Australia at concession fares under any Act, regulation or by-law for the time being in force, shall be two dollars.

3. Section 79a of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the present contents thereof (which are hereby designated subsection (1) thereof) the following subsection:—

(2) On and after the first day of January, 1971, the fee for the conduct of any practical driving test referred to in subsection (1) of this section shall be one dollar and on and after that day a member of the police force referred to in that subsection shall not conduct any such test unless he is satisfied that that fee has been paid.
