An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1961-1974.

[Assented to 20th March, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1975". Short titles.

(2) The Road Traffic Act, 1961-1974, as amended by all other amendments made prior to the commencement of this Act, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act, 1961-1975".

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of March, 1975. Commencement.

3. Section 63 of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end of subsection (1) the following passage:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 63—

Penalty: One hundred dollars.

Giving way at intersections and junctions.
