An Act to amend the Renmark Irrigation Trust Act, 1936-1978.

[Assented to 21st September, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Renmark Irrigation Trust Act Amendment Act, 1978". Short titles.

(2) The Renmark Irrigation Trust Act, 1936-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Renmark Irrigation Trust Act, 1936-1978".

2. Section 60 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "for irrigation and domestic purposes". Amendment of principal Act, s. 60—
Trust may lay pipes for supply to townships.

3. Section 64 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:— Repeal of s. 64 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place.

64. (1) The Trust may, upon such terms and conditions as it thinks fit— Supply of water to persons otherwise not entitled thereto.

(a) supply water to any person in excess of the quantity of water to which that person is otherwise entitled under this Act;

(b) supply water to any person who is not otherwise entitled to be supplied with water under this Act.

(2) The terms and conditions stipulated by the Trust under this section must conform with any relevant regulation or by-law under this Act.

4. Section 73 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the passage “Subject to the approval of the Minister, the trust may, from time to time, make regulations and by-laws for or relating to all or any of the following subjects” and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “The trust may, with the approval of the Minister, make regulations or by-laws for or incidental to the implementation of the purposes for which the trust is constituted or to facilitate the exercise by the trust of its powers under this Act, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing the regulations or by-laws may relate to the following subjects”;

(b) by striking out paragraph IIIa;

and

(c) by striking out paragraphs XII and XIII and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraphs:—

XII. The terms and conditions that the trust may impose in relation to the supply of water:

XIII. The measurement of water supplied by the trust:

XIV. The granting, suspension and revocation of licences authorizing the diversion or taking of waters supplying or flowing into, any aqueduct, waterworks, stream, or reservoir in the district:

XV. Imposing penalties, not exceeding two hundred dollars, for a breach of any regulation or by-law:.
