An Act to amend the Governors' Pensions Act, 1976.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Governors' Pensions Act Amendment Act, 1981".

(2) The Governors' Pensions Act, 1976, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Governors' Pensions Act, 1976-1981".

 Interpretation.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) of the definition of "former Governor" and substituting the following subparagraph:

(i) after having served in that office for a period (excluding periods of furlough) of not less than four years and six months;;

and

(b) by inserting after the definition of "former Governor" the following definition:

"furlough", in relation to a Governor, means absence from office for recreational purposes for a continuous period of more than one month.:
