**An Act to amend the Film Classification Act, 1971.**

*[Assented to 22 December 1983]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Film Classification Act Amendment Act, 1983".

(2) The Film Classification Act, 1971, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

3. Section 1 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "Film Classification" and substituting the passage "Classification of Films for Public Exhibition".

4. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraph:

(b) parental guidance recommended;
