**An Act to amend the Marketing of Eggs Act, 1941, and to make a consequential amendment to the Egg Industry Stabilization Act, 1973.**

*[Assented to 22 December 1983]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Marketing of Eggs Act Amendment Act, 1983". Short title.

(2) The Marketing of Eggs Act, 1941, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection: Amendment of s. 4—  
Constitution of board.

(2) The board shall consist of seven members of whom—

(a) three shall be elected in accordance with section 4a;

and

(b) four shall be persons appointed by the Governor.

3. The Egg Industry Stabilization Act, 1973, is amended—

(a) in section 6 by striking out from subsection (2) the word "three";

(b) in section 7 by striking out from subsection (4) the word "Two" and substituting the word "Three". Amendment of Egg Industry Stabilization Act, 1973.
