An Act to amend the Justices Act, 1921.

[Assented to 10 April 1986]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Justices Act Amendment Act, 1986". Short title.

(2) The Justices Act, 1921, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 27a of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (3) (b) (i) the passage "three months" and substituting the passage "four months". Amendment of section 27a—
Service of summons by post.
