An Act to amend the Classification of Publications Act 1974.

[Assented to 20 May 1993]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Classification of Publications (Display of Indecent Matter) Amendment Act 1993*.

(2) The *Classification of Publications Act 1974* is referred to in this Act as “the principal Act”.

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 13—Classification of publications

3. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after “sex” in paragraph (a) of the definition of “prescribed matters” in subsection (3a) “including demeaning images”.

Amendment of s. 14a—Conditions applying to restricted publications

4. Section 14a of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraphs:

(b) a condition that the publication must not be displayed in a place to which the public has access (not being a restricted publications area) unless the publication is—

(i) contained in a sealed package and placed in a rack or other receptacle that prevents the display of any prescribed matter;

or

(ii) contained in opaque material (being opaque material that does not depict any prescribed matter);

(c) a condition that the publication must not be advertised in a manner that depicts any prescribed matter except—

- (i) in a restricted publications area;
- (ii) in another category 1 restricted publication;
- (iii) in a category 2 restricted publication;
- or
- (iv) by way of printed or written material delivered to a person at the written request of the person.;

and

(b) by inserting after subsection (3) the following subsection:

(4) In this section—

“prescribed matter” has the meaning assigned to the expression by section 13(3a).
