An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1934.

[Assented to 26 August 1993]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Local Government (Voting at Meetings) Amendment Act 1993.
 - (2) The Local Government Act 1934 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 60—Procedure at meetings

- 3. Section 60 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:
 - (3) Subject to this Act, a question arising for decision at a meeting of a council will be decided by a majority of the votes cast by the members present at the meeting and entitled to vote on the question.
