An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1934.

[Assented to 26 August 1993]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Local Government (Voting at Meetings) Amendment Act 1993*.

(2) The *Local Government Act 1934* is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 60—Procedure at meetings

3. Section 60 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:

(3) Subject to this Act, a question arising for decision at a meeting of a council will be decided by a majority of the votes cast by the members present at the meeting and entitled to vote on the question.
