Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—Associated Direction No 3) (COVID-19) Direction 2021

under section 25 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004*

Preamble

- 1 On 22 March 2020, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being the State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the Act that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia.
 - 2 Now I, Linda Williams, Acting Commissioner of Police and State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia, being of the opinion that this is necessary to achieve the purposes of the Act, give the following directions pursuant to section 25 of the Act.
 - 3 This direction is to operate as an appendix to the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—General) (COVID-19) Direction 2021*.
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1—Citation

This direction may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—Associated Direction No 3) (COVID-19) Direction 2021*.

2—Revocation

The *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—Associated Direction No 2) (COVID-19) Direction 2021* is revoked.

3—Interpretation

In this direction—

New South Wales restricted zone means the restricted zone declared under clause 6(2);

New South Wales restricted arrival means a person arriving in South Australia who has, at any time during the period of 14 days before their arrival, been in the New South Wales restricted zone;

New Zealand arrival—an overseas arrival is a New Zealand arrival if the only location outside of Australia that they have been in during the period of 14 days before their arrival in South Australia is New Zealand;

Queensland restricted zone means the restricted zone declared under clause 6(1);

Queensland restricted arrival means a person arriving in South Australia who has, at any time during the period of 14 days before their arrival, been in the Queensland restricted zone;

4—Application of cross border requirements—overseas arrivals

An arrival from a location specified in the first column of the table below who is of a class specified in the second column of the table is subject to requirements of the level specified in the third column of the table:

Location	Class of person	Level of requirements
Overseas	All overseas arrivals (other than New Zealand arrivals)	Level 5

5—Application of cross border requirements—Queensland and New South Wales arrivals

An arrival from a location specified in the first column of the table below who is of a class specified in the second column of the table is subject to requirements of the level specified in the third column of the table:

Location	Class of person	Level of requirements
Queensland restricted zone	Queensland restricted arrivals arriving in South Australia	Level 3
New South Wales restricted zone	New South Wales restricted arrivals arriving in South Australia	Level 3

6—Declaration of restricted zones

- (1) The area in the State of Queensland comprised of the following local government areas is declared to be a restricted zone:
 - (a) City of Brisbane;
 - (b) City of Ipswich;
 - (c) Logan City;
 - (d) Moreton Bay Region;
 - (e) Redland City.

- (2) The area in the State of New South Wales comprised of the following local government areas is declared to be a restricted zone:
- (a) Byron Shire Council.
