Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—Associated Direction No 9) (COVID-19) Direction 2021

under section 25 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004*

Preamble

- 1 On 22 March 2020, I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being the State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the Act that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia.
 - 2 Now I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police and State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia, being of the opinion that this is necessary to achieve the purposes of the Act, give the following directions pursuant to section 25 of the Act.
 - 3 This direction is to operate as an appendix to the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—General) (COVID-19) Direction 2021*.

1—Citation

This direction may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—Associated Direction No 9) (COVID-19) Direction 2021*.

2—Revocation

The *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—Associated Direction No 8) (COVID-19) Direction 2021* is revoked.

3—Interpretation

In this direction—

designated exposure site means:

- (a) in relation to the New South Wales restricted zone, means one of the sites in that zone listed from time to time as “COVID-19 case locations” on the following website maintained by the Government of New South Wales:

- (b) in relation to the Victorian restricted zone, means one of the sites in that zone listed from time to time as “Tier 1 public exposure sites” or “Tier 2 public exposure sites” on the following website maintained by the Government of Victoria:

New Zealand arrival—an overseas arrival is a New Zealand arrival if the only location outside of Australia that they have been in during the period of 14 days before their arrival in South Australia is New Zealand;

New South Wales restricted zone means the restricted zone declared under subclause 6(1);

New South Wales restricted arrival means a person arriving in South Australia who has been at a designated exposure site in the New South Wales restricted zone at a relevant time;

relevant time, in relation to the New South Wales or Victorian restricted zones, means a time and date specified in relation to a corresponding exposure site within the relevant restricted zone;

Victorian restricted arrival means a person arriving in South Australia who has been at a designated exposure site in the Victorian restricted zone at a relevant time;

Victorian restricted zone means the restricted zone declared under subclause 6(2).

4—Application of cross border requirements—overseas arrivals

An arrival from a location specified in the first column of the table below who is of a class specified in the second column of the table is subject to requirements of the level specified in the third column of the table:

5—Application of cross border requirements—New South Wales and Victorian arrivals

An arrival from a location specified in the first column of the table below who is of a class specified in the second column of the table is subject to requirements of the level specified in the third column of the table:

6—Declaration of restricted zones

- (1) The area in the State of New South Wales comprised of the designated exposure sites is declared to be a restricted zone.
- (2) The area in the State of Victoria comprised of the designated exposure sites is declared to be a restricted zone.
