## **Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel— Associated Direction No 12) (COVID-19) Direction 2021**

under section 25 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004*

---

### **Preamble**

- 1 On 22 March 2020, I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being the State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the *Act* that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia.
  - 2 Now I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police and State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia, being of the opinion that this is necessary to achieve the purposes of the *Act*, give the following directions pursuant to section 25 of the *Act*.
  - 3 This direction is to operate as an appendix to the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—General) (COVID-19) Direction 2021*.

### **1—Citation**

This direction may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—Associated Direction No 12) (COVID-19) Direction 2021*.

### **2—Revocation**

The *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—Associated Direction No 11) (COVID-19) Direction 2021* is revoked.

### **3—Interpretation**

In this direction—

***designated exposure site***, in relation to Victorian restricted zone A, means one of the sites in that zone listed from time to time as “Tier 1 public exposure sites” or “Tier 2 public exposure sites” on the following website maintained by the Government of Victoria: <https://www.coronavirus.vic.gov.au/exposure-sites>;

***New Zealand arrival***—an overseas arrival is a New Zealand arrival if the only location outside of Australia that they have been in during the period of 14 days before their arrival in South Australia is New Zealand;

**relevant time**, in relation to Victorian restricted zone A, means a time and date specified in relation to a corresponding exposure site within the relevant restricted zone;

**Victorian restricted zone A arrival** means a person arriving in South Australia who has been at a designated exposure site in the Victorian restricted zone at a relevant time;

**Victorian restricted zone B arrival** means a person arriving in South Australia who has been in the Victorian restricted zone B, but has not been at a Victorian restricted zone A designated exposure site at a relevant time;

**Note—**

Some zone A exposure sites are in zone B: the directions for zone A arrivals take precedence over the directions for zone B arrivals—

**Example:** A person who was at Highpoint Shopping Centre on 20 May during the period 5pm to 8pm (an exposure site in Victorian restricted zone A, which is also located in zone B), must comply with the directions for restricted zone A arrivals, not the directions for restricted zone B arrivals.

**Victorian restricted zones** mean the restricted zones declared under clause 6.

#### 4—Application of cross border requirements—overseas arrivals

An arrival from a location specified in the first column of the table below who is of a class specified in the second column of the table is subject to requirements of the level specified in the third column of the table:

<b>Location</b>	<b>Class of person</b>	<b>Level of requirements</b>
Overseas	All overseas arrivals (other than New Zealand arrivals)	Level 5

#### 5—Application of cross border requirements—Victorian arrivals

(1) An arrival from a location specified in the first column of the table below who is of a class specified in the second column of the table is subject to requirements of the level specified in the third column of the table:

Victorian restricted zone B	Victorian restricted zone B arrivals arriving in South Australia before the commencement of this associated direction (including essential travellers and permitted arrivals) who were in Victorian restricted zone B on or after 6 May 2021.	Level 2, with the modifications set out in subclause (2)
Victorian restricted zone B	Victorian restricted zone B arrivals arriving in South Australia after the commencement of this associated direction (including essential travellers and permitted arrivals) who were in Victorian restricted zone B at any time in the 14 days preceding their arrival.	Level 2

- (2) The modifications to the requirements for Victorian restricted zone B arrivals arriving in South Australia before the commencement of this associated direction are as follows:—
- (a) the 24-hour period from the commencement of this direction is taken to be Day 1; and
  - (b) no test is required on Days 5 and 13 if the person has received a negative result from the Day 1 test.

## 6—Declaration of restricted zone

- (1) The area in the State of Victoria comprised of the designated exposure sites is declared to be Victorian restricted zone A;

- (2) The local government area in the State of Victoria comprised of the City of Whittlesea is declared to be Victorian restricted zone B.
