


EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACT 2004

REVOCATION OF DECLARATION OF A MAJOR EMERGENCY  
COVID-19

- 1 On 22 March 2020 I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being the State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the Act that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia (the *Declaration*).
- 2 The Declaration remains in force pursuant to approvals given from time to time by the Governor and Administrator pursuant to section 23(2) of the Act.
- 3 I now revoke the Declaration pursuant to section 23(3) of the Act effective from the
