# Emergency Management (Revocation of Activities - Associated Direction No 14A) (COVID-19) Direction 2021

under section 25 of the Emergency Management Act 2004

# Preamble

- On 22 March 2020 I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being the State Coordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the Act that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia.
- Now I, Grantley Stevens, being of the opinion that this is necessary to achieve the purposes of the Act, give the following directions pursuant to section 25 of the Act.
- This direction is to operate as an appendix to the *Emergency Management* (Activities—General No 3) (COVID-19) Direction 2021 or to any direction that replaces that direction, and modifies that direction.

# 1—Citation

This direction may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Revocation of Activities - Associated Direction No 14A) (COVID-19) Direction 2021.* 

# 2—Purpose

The purpose of this direction is to revoke the restrictions in relation to the declared area under *Emergency Management (Activities—Associated Direction No 14A)* (COVID-19) Direction 2021.

# 3—Revocation
